(解説)

$$2\frac{1}{6} + \underbrace{\square \times 0.6}_{\square} = 2\frac{17}{30}$$

ココをまとめる。

$$\square = 2\frac{17}{30} - 2\frac{1}{6}$$

$$= 2\frac{17}{30} - 2\frac{5}{30}$$

$$= \frac{12}{30}$$

$$= \frac{2}{5}$$

$$\square \times 0.6 = \frac{2}{5}$$

$$\square \times \frac{3}{5} = \frac{2}{5}$$

$$\square = \frac{2}{5} \div \frac{3}{5}$$

$$= \frac{2}{5} \times \frac{5}{3}$$

$$= \frac{2}{3}$$
